**Liquidated Damage (LD) / Penalty:**

Subject to force majeure, if vendor fails to complete the job as per aforesaid completion / delivery period, BHEL shall have the right to recover as liquidated damages (LD) a sum equivalent to 0.5% of undelivered p

portion of the order value for delay of each week or part thereof. The liability for delay shall not in any case exceed 10% (ten percent) of the order value. For this purpose, the period of delay shall be the delay attributable to vendor for completion of job as per contract.

In case of LD recovery, the applicable GST shall also be recovered from vendor.

#### **Other Terms & Conditions:**

Supplied materials if found not meeting the quality requirement as per standard and technical specification or found damaged/defective during inspection and verification, will be rejected by BHEL and such item(s) to be replaced/replenished free of cost by the supplier within 7 days from the date of rejection advice. No payment shall be made against rejected/defective supply.

The quotation should be valid at least for a period of 90 (Ninety) days from the tender due date of submission (extended, if any). Price Variation Clause will not be entertained.

#### **Taxes, Duties etc.**

1. Bidder's quoted/ accepted rates/ price shall be inclusive of all taxes including GST, Charges, Royalties, any State or Central Levy and other taxes for materials if any obtained for the work and for execution of the contract.

Any increase of above at any stage during execution of contract, including extension of the contract, shall have to be borne by successful bidder contractor. However, any increase of GST subsequent to due date of offer submission as per NIT & TCN, by statutory authority during contract period (including extension, if the same is not attributable to you), shall be reimbursed by BHEL on production of relevant supporting document to the satisfaction of BHEL.

3. Since GST on output will be paid by BHEL as enumerated above, bidder's quoted rates / price should be after considering the Input Credit under GST law at bidder's end.
