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1. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore): Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. 2. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the

offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25%(selected by Buyer) percentage of total QUANTITY. OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

a) Belting is also acceptable with a tolerance on length of + 2% (max) . Any belt with negative tolerance i.e where the belt length is less than the Reel Length given in the order shall not be accepted and is liable for rejection. Payment will be made only for PO quantity

b) After installation of the supplied conveyor belting, if any manufacturing defect is found in the installed belt within the guarantee period, the party is liable to replace the defective supply free of cost within reasonable time of the intimation. Further the party has to bear the installation cost at site, of the defective supply.

c) In addition to point b above, the supplied belt shall be considered defective if: a) The length of the belting is found shorter than the invoiced length. b) Marking on supplied belt drum and belt not found as per IS /IPSS requirement. c) Any of splice joint(s) made by manufacturers at their premises in the supplied belt fails within the guarantee period. The party is liable to replace such defective supply free of cost within reasonable time of the intimation and if party fails to do so, cost of belt shall be recovered from the party.

d) Marking: - Cumulative length of the belt shall be painted at every 10 meter on carrying side of the belt and also at end of every belt reel. The belt shall not be accepted and is liable for rejection if marking is not as per applicable IS /IPSS requirement.

e) Conveyor belt may also be packed suitably in steel drums. No extra payment will be made towards any additional cost incurred in steel drums in place of wooden drums.

f)The belt manufacturers may use belt fabrics of any make procured from any ISO certified belt fabrics manufacturers of India. While participating in bid, Bidder has to undertake compliance of this and any false declaration and non-compliance of this would be a ground for immediate termination of the contract and further legal action

in accordance with the laws./जेम की सामान्य शर्तों के खंड 26 के संदर्भ में भारत के साथ भूमि सीमा साझा करने वाले देश के बिडर से खरीद पर प्रतिबंध के संबंध में भारत के साथ भूमि सीमा साझा करने वाले देश का कोई भी बिडर इस निविदा में बिड देने के लिए तभी पात्र होगा जब वह बिड देने वाला सक्षम प्राधिकारी के पास पंजीकृत हो। बिड में भाग लेते समय बिडर को इसका अनुपालन करना होगा और कोई भी गलत घोषणा किए जाने व इसका अनुपालन न करने पर अनुबंध को तत्काल समाप्त करने और कानून के अनुसार आगे की कानूनी कार्रवाई का आधार होगा।
